

VI. Required Essay: It is important that candidates devote sufficient attention to the following required essay. Type an essay (1000 – 1500 words and in MLA format) including a Biblical Worldview.

The four tenets of the National Honor Society are scholarship, character, service, and leadership.

The National Honor Society focuses on the personal traits of scholarship, character, service, and leadership.

These attributes actually do not exist apart from one another; they exist together one affecting the other (s). We will, however, look at just one such relationship here: the trait of character and how it affects scholarship, service, and leadership.

In a MLA-formatted essay of your best writing (1000 – 1005 words), address the following prompt:

Explain how your character as a follower of Christ has affected and will affect your scholarship, service, and leadership.
